



MONTREAL GATEWAY TERMINALS

EMPTY CONTAINER RETURN POLICY

When containers supplied by or on behalf of the Carrier are unpacked at the consignees or consignee's representatives designated area, they along with the road carrier are responsible for returning the empty container(s) in "Ready for use" condition.

The following steps must be taken to ensure compliance with this policy:

- a. Containers hazardous placards must be removed
- b. All packaging materials must be removed
- c. Containers interiors must be inspected and swept for debris
- d. Containers must be odor free and steam cleaned if warranted
- e. Visible evidence of spills must be steam cleaned if warranted
- f. Holes and other significant damage evident on containers must be reported to the entry gate personnel.

{MINOR DENTS ARE ACCEPTABLE PROVIDED THEY DON'T INTERFERE WITH LOADING IN CELL GUIDES.}
